**SUMMERTIME LEISURE:** I already notice that there are less people at the 5:15 PM Mass and more people at the 7:00 PM Mass on Saturdays as summer begins. Many of us travel more on weekends during the summer. If you do so, plan Sunday Mass into the weekend as surely as you plan lodging and eating. This way you fulfill the Third Commandment, and you experience how vast our holy Catholic Church is. The experience of participating in Mass in many different places is so healthy for our children. Finally, it is a sin to miss Sunday Mass without an excusing cause; it must be an honest excusing cause, not just any reason.

**SUMMERTIME CONTRIBUTIONS:** I think most of our parishioners follow the report of our income from week to week. By your steady contributions and by the disciplined spending by school and parish staff, we are staying "in the black". Summertime always leaves me concerned about parish income. If you are traveling on weekends, please remember that St. Peter's still needs your financial support. Nearly everyone on parish and school staff gets paid over a twelve-month period; so our bills are about the same in the summer. If the location of our Sunday Masses in the gym leaves you wanting to go to Mass elsewhere, please remember our need for your financial support here. In brief, St. Peter's needs your faithful tithe in the summer as much as the rest of the year.
