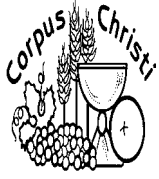

On this Feast of Corpus Christi, please give some thought to these words of St. Thomas Aquinas: *"Since it was the will of God's only-begotten Son that people should share in His divinity, He assumed our nature in order that by becoming man He might make men gods. Moreover, when He took our flesh He dedicated the whole of its substance to our salvation. He offered His body to God the Father on the altar of the cross as a sacrifice for our reconciliation. He shed His blood for our ransom and purification, so that we might be redeemed from our wretched state of bondage and cleansed from all sin. But to ensure that the memory of so great a gift would abide with us forever, He left His body as food and His blood as drink for the faithful to consume in the form of bread and wine."*

Jesus commanded His apostles to, *"Do this in memory of me."* Christ's one sacrifice extends beyond Calvary to every altar at every Eucharist celebrated worldwide. Through the priest, Jesus offers Himself and transforms mere bread and wine into heavenly food that nourishes and unites God's people. The Real Presence is our pledge of salvation, won for us by the one Lord and Savior of the world.
