RCIA—Adult Initiation

On Sunday, June 9th, several of our Candidates and Catechumen's will be celebrating a combined Rite of Acceptance and Welcome at the 10:30 Mass. This is the first public ritual that they will experience in their journey toward the waters of baptism or full communion with the Church. It is a ritual that should take place during a Sunday celebration of the Eucharist so that members of the faithful may be present to acknowledge their continuing support. Most of the ritual will be unseen by those assembled because it takes place at the entrance of the Church (in the lobby). When this ritual is celebrated it takes the place of the Penitential Rite and the Gloria, so don't worry about how much time this ritual adds to the Mass. It is our prayer that you joyfully welcome these candidates and catechumens and support them in their ongoing journey of faith.

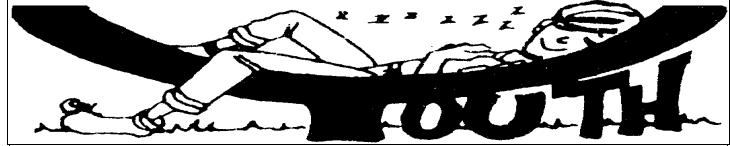
ORDINATION
